Amartya Sen is a renowned economist, philosopher, and Nobel laureate who has made significant contributions to the field of welfare economics, development economics, and social choice theory. 1. **Early Life and Education:** Born on November 3, 1933, in Santiniketan, India, Amartya Sen had a diverse upbringing influenced by his family's academic background and exposure to different cultures. He attended Presidency College in Kolkata and later pursued his studies at Trinity College, Cambridge.
2. **Contributions to Welfare Economics:** Sen's work has focused on broadening the perspective of welfare economics beyond traditional income-based metrics. He introduced the concept of "capabilities" as a basis for measuring well-being, emphasizing the importance of individuals' abilities to function and lead lives they value. His influential book, "Development as Freedom," explores the relationship between freedom, development, and human well-being.
3. **Development Economics and Poverty:** Sen's research has also examined the causes of poverty and the complexities of development. He has highlighted the importance of addressing social, political, and economic factors that perpetuate poverty and inequality.

Common Service Centers (CSCs) are part of the Government of India's Digital India initiative, aimed at providing various public services to citizens in rural and remote areas. CSCs act as access points for a wide range of government and private sector services, including digital literacy, Aadhar card enrolment, and utility bill payments. They are typically operated by local entrepreneurs, known as Village Level Entrepreneurs (VLEs), who help bridge the digital divide in underserved regions. CSCs offer services related to banking, education, healthcare, and agriculture, making them vital for rural development and inclusive growth. These centres play a crucial role in promoting e-governance and digital empowerment by bringing essential services closer to citizens in rural India.
