The Importance of Cleanliness in Nursing

- ◆ She emphasized the need for sanitation, and in doing so created the first evidence-based practice
- ◆ She acknowledged the impact the environment was having on her patients even before bacterial infections had been discovered, exemplifying incredible critical thinking skills
- ◆ She understood the role the environment played, and created the first nursing metaparadigm, linking person, nursing, health and the environment.

(Selanders 2023)

Changing the Public Perception of Nursing

- ◆ Nightingale used her popularity and social and political relationships to influence change and lobby for improved public health
- ◆ She inspired many affluent women who then went on and continued her teachings
- ◆ She published Notes on Nursing which involved aspects still included in nursing today, including confidentiality, cleanliness, observation, assessment, quality and safety

Early life

- ◆ Florence Nightingale was born on the 12th of May 1820 in Florence, Italy
- ◆ She was well educated, with her father teaching languages, mathematics and science
- ◆ She wanted to be a nurse from an early age, but her parents forbade her due to the poor reputation it held
- ◆ In 1851 against her parents wishes, she studied nursing in Germany and France

(Strickler 2017)

Crimean war

- ◆ Nightingale led a group of 38 nurses to the barrack hospital in Scutari to improve the poor conditions and high mortality rate
- ◆ On arrival she saw horrific conditions and she became convinced these were impacting the health of the casualties
- ◆ During the nights while the nurses slept, she did her rounds with a lamp caring for the patients during the night, giving herself the name 'The lady with the lamp'

ACTIVE VOICE

The active voice illustrates a sentence where the subject performs the action that stated by the verb.

Form: SUBJECT + VERB + OBJECT.

- *I do my home work.*
- *My mom cooks the dinner.*
- *Our teacher gives us a lot of homework.*
- *She receives a letter from her father.*

PASSIVE VOICE

In contrast, passive voice is describe a sentence in which the subject receives an action.

Form: SUBJECT + VERB + "TO BE" + PAST PARTICIPLE.



WHEN TO USE PASSIVE VOICE?

1. In formal texts

Examples:

- **Active:** *They invite him to the party.*
- **Passive:** *He is invited to the party.*
(sounds more formal)

2. To show interest in the person or object that receive an action rather than the person or object that performs the action.

Examples:

- *The party was held in a luxury hotel.*
(we're interest in the party rather than who held it.)
- *All tickets were sold out!* *(we're interest in the ticket rather than who sold it.)*

3. When we don't know (or do not want to express) who performed the action.

- *My purse was stolen!*
- *A whole pot of jam was eaten!*

FUTURE TENSE WITH GOING TO

- **Active:** S + am/are/is going to + V1 + O.
- **Passive:** S + am/are/is going to be + V3.
