Special lectures are organized to discuss the philosophical aspects of the Gita.



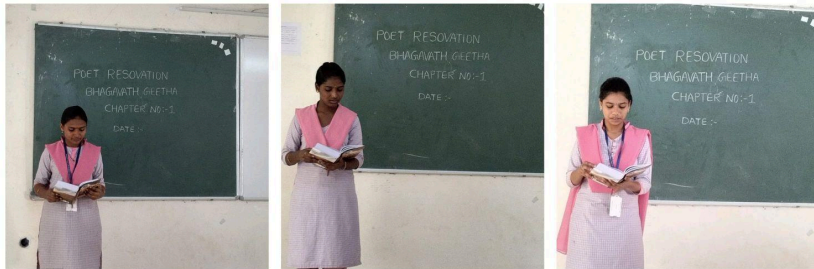

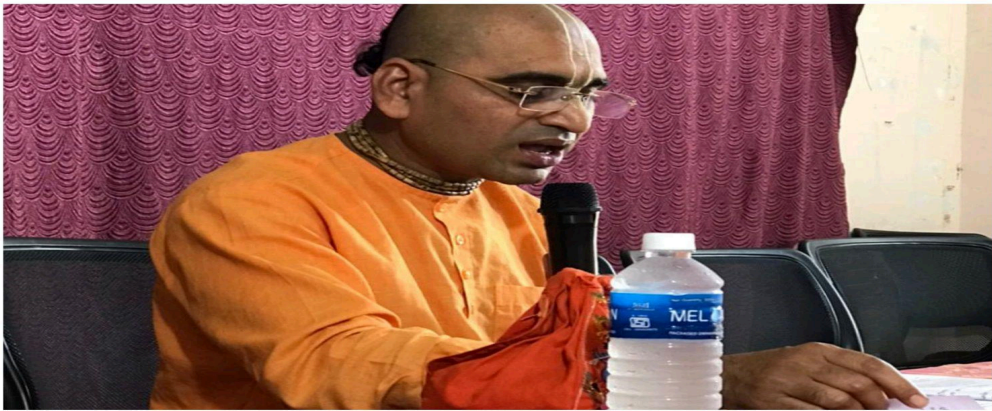

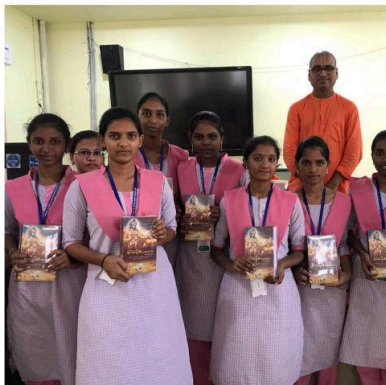
