# REPORT ON THE ONLINE QUIZ

On 19-02-2026, an online quiz was conducted using Quizizz-Wayground, targeting II B.Sc. Computer Science- Minor students. The quiz focused on fundamental concepts in database management systems, aiming to enhance students' understanding while providing an engaging platform for assessment. With the growing reliance on digital tools in education, Quizizz was chosen for its interactive features and user-friendly interface. A total of 26 students had participated in the quiz enthusiastically.

## Objectives

The primary objectives of the quiz were as follows:

1. **Assess Knowledge:** To evaluate students' grasp of key data structure concepts.
2. **Promote Engagement:** To foster a fun and competitive learning environment.
3. **Identify Learning Gaps:** To pinpoint areas where students require additional support or instruction.

## Methodology

### Preparation

Questions were developed based on the course syllabus and aligned with learning outcomes. A mix of conceptual questions and practical scenarios was included to ensure a comprehensive assessment.

### Administration

The quiz was administered online, allowing students to participate remotely. Instructions were sent via email, and a dedicated time slot was allocated for the quiz to ensure all students could attend.

### Monitoring


Participation was tracked through the Quizizz platform. Immediate feedback was provided to students upon completion, allowing them to review their answers and learn from their mistakes.




### Analysis of the Quiz conducted
