The Three Types of Breast Milk

Breast milk is not a static substance — it evolves dynamically to meet the changing needs of the growing infant. Each stage offers unique nutritional and immunological properties.

Colostrum — "Liquid Gold"

Days 1-5. Thick, yellow, and rich in antibodies (IgA), proteins, and white blood cells. It coats the infant's gut, providing the first line of immune defence and helping pass meconium.

Transitional Milk

Days 5-14. A blend of colostrum and mature milk. Volume increases significantly, and fat, lactose, and calorie content rise to support rapid infant growth.

Mature Milk

After 2 weeks. Appears thinner and whiter. Contains **foremilk** (watery, thirst-quenching) and **hindmilk** (creamy, fat-rich). Composition continues to adapt throughout lactation.

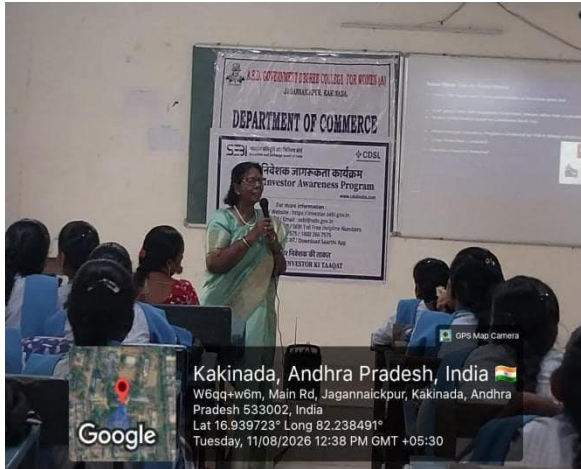

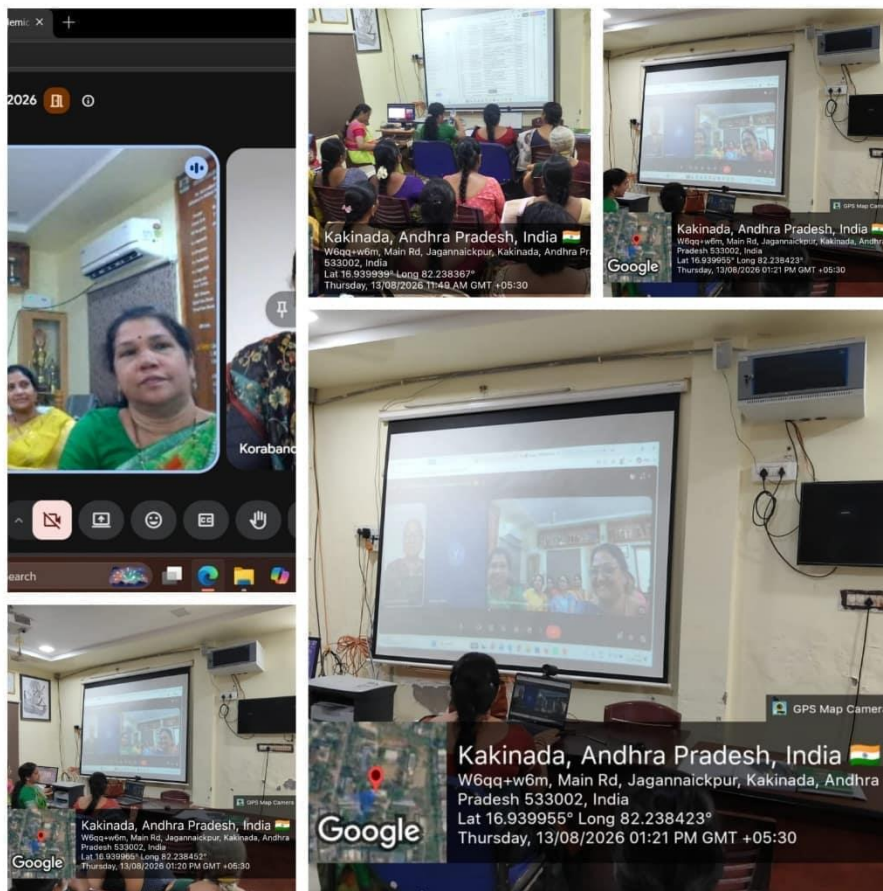


ORGANIZATION OF ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE'S AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON 13-08-2026

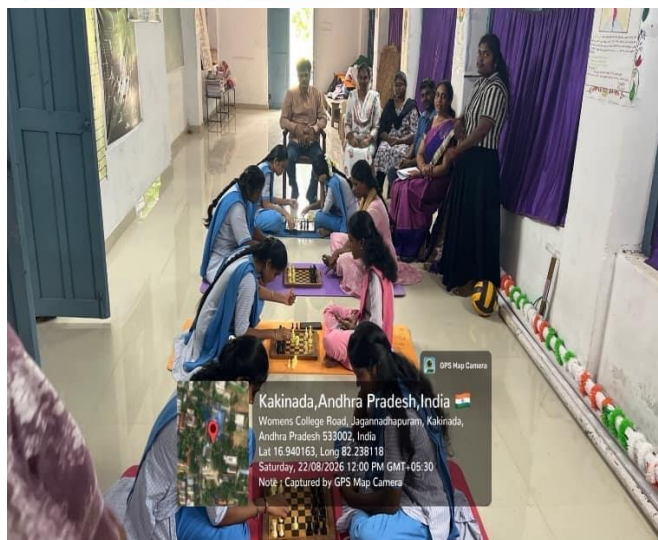

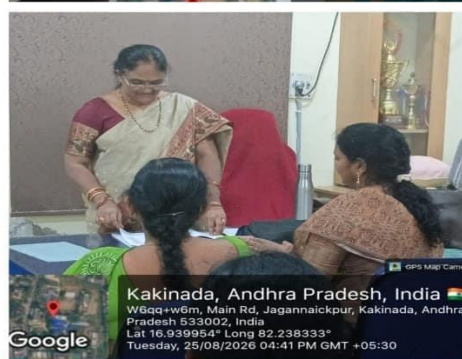
