Activities with Padala Charitable Trust, Kakinada as a part of MoU

Department of Home Science entered into an MoU with Padala Charitable Trust, Kakinada on 12.09.2022. The activities to be covered under MoU for mutual benefit of the parties include skill development of students through internships, support the development of stakeholders through training programmes ,sharing the knowledge resources and infrastructure facilities, organizing guest lectures/conferences or any other academic related activities etc.,

 As a part of Short Term Internship programmes of the students of Home Science department, Project VIP(Volunteers in Public Service) was designed by PCT, Kakinada .As a part of this,18 students were trained in NGO Management work, Account Keeping, teaching material preparation ,conducting the sessions in schools ,documentation and computerization of the work done. Interns have been trained for SFLB (Sweccha for Little Birds),Varadhi (Programme for children of single parents), Swacch (Menstrual Hygiene for girls) in which school children are trained recognising body parts, private parts, good touch, bad touch, POCSO Act, Child Helpline, menstrual hygiene for girls etc., Totally during the internship,59 schools and nearly 5000 students were educated.









2. Skill development programme-Puppetry Training: As a part of MoU, a workshop in Puppetry training was conducted on 29-9-2022. For the graduates of home science who work with mostly community and preschool children, puppetry can be the most effective and creative form of teaching. puppets grab the audience attention and sustain it. Not only the audience but also the presenters are benefited as it creates an opportunity to improve their creativity ,aesthetic sense and self expression. Sri.Govinda Rajulu garu who is a state awardee in puppetry acted as the resource person.18 students of home science and 6 employees of CT were trained in the workshop.





3.An extension programme was conducted along with PCT,Kakinada from 28th December to 30th December 2023 in the schools of Kakinada district .As a part of this, 43 students of II B.Sc and I B.Sc Home Science were trained in educating the school students on protecting themselves from sexual abuse.These students in turn educated the students of schools in and round Kakinada.Nearly 10 schools and 400 school children were covered as a part of this programme.
