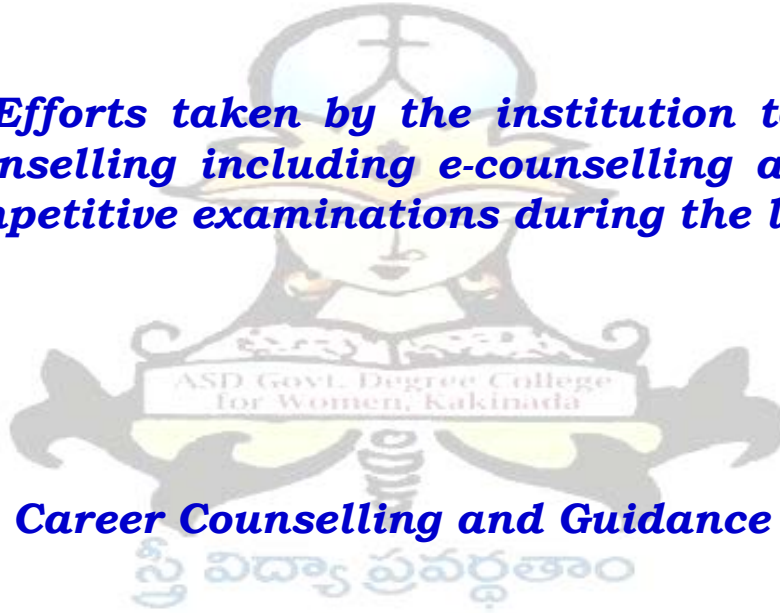



Future Plans

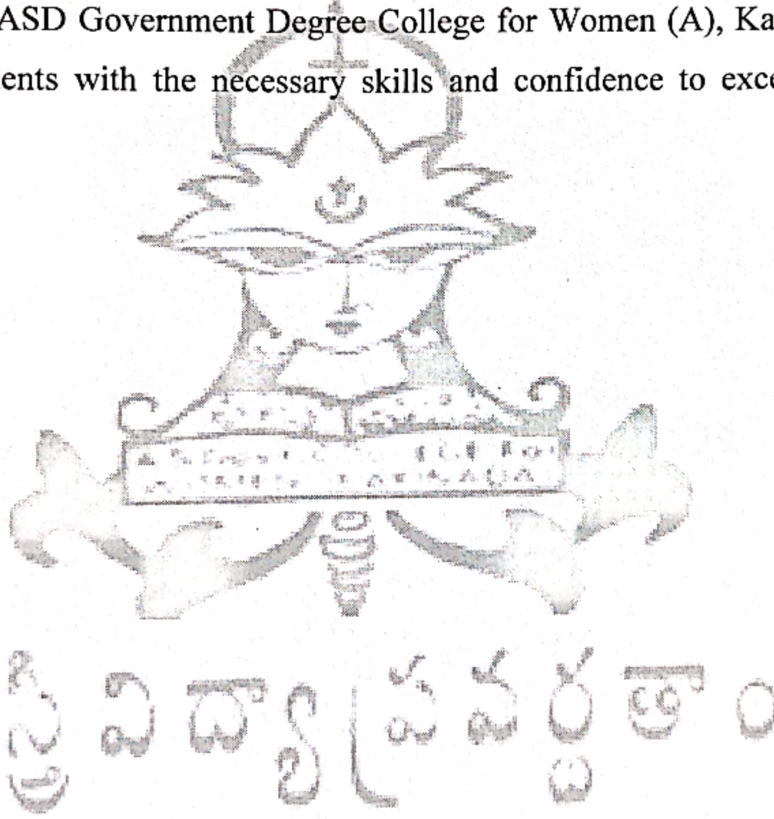
Based on the positive feedback and the constructive outcomes of this mock test, the following future plans have been outlined:

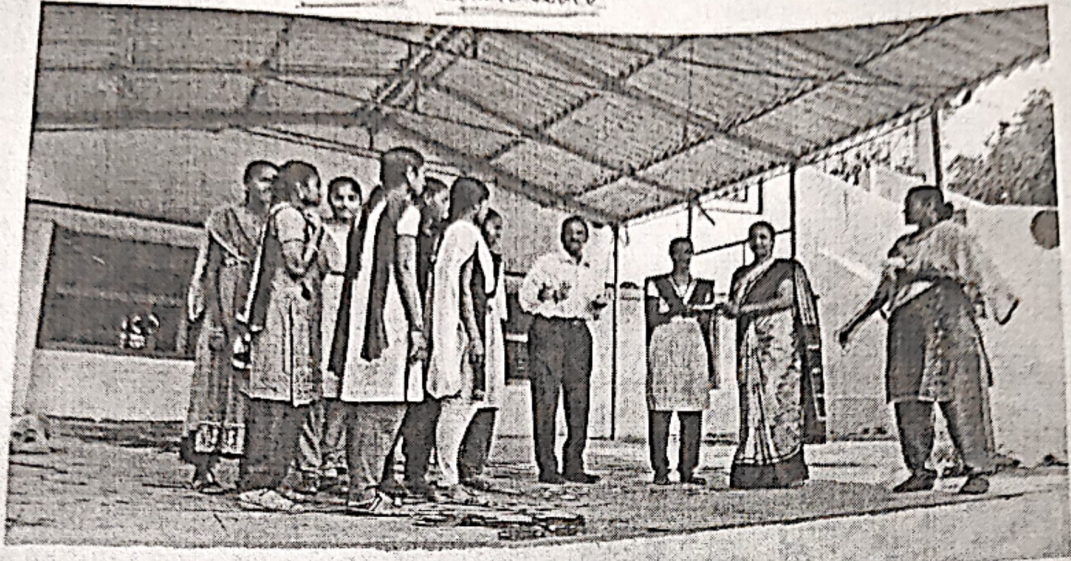


