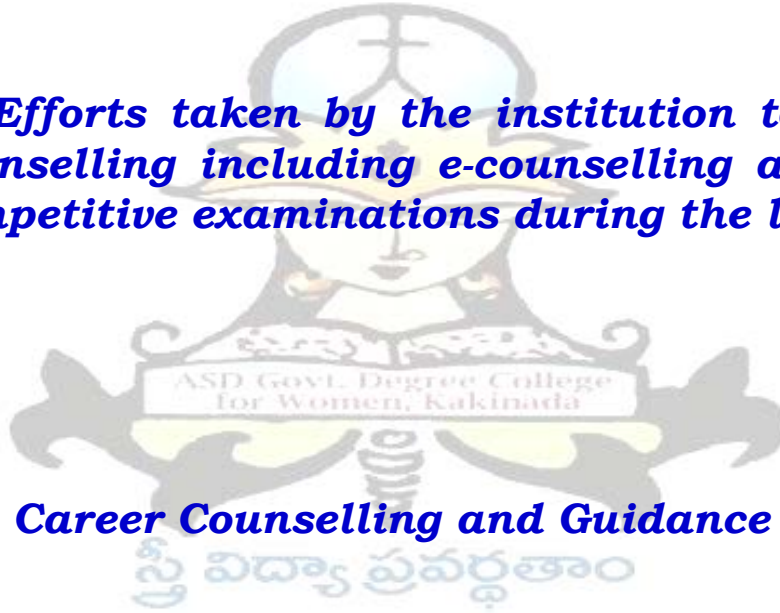

2. **Setting Realistic Goals:** Students were encouraged to set realistic and achievable goals for themselves. Breaking down the study material into manageable chunks and setting short-term milestones can help alleviate the overwhelming pressure associated with competitive exams.
3. **Effective Time Management:** Time management emerged as a crucial factor in facing competitive exams. The speaker emphasized the importance of creating a well-structured study schedule that allows for adequate breaks and recreation. Proper time allocation to each subject and regular revisions were highlighted as essential components of effective time management.
4. **Adopting Healthy Study Habits:** The lecture emphasized the significance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle during the preparation period. A balanced diet, sufficient sleep, and regular exercise were cited as essential elements to enhance cognitive function and overall well-being.
5. **Mindfulness and Relaxation Techniques:** Practical mindfulness and relaxation techniques, such as deep breathing exercises and meditation, were introduced to help students manage stress and stay focused during study sessions. The speaker highlighted the role of mindfulness in cultivating a positive mindset.
6. **Learning from Setbacks:** Facing setbacks and failures is an inherent part of any competitive journey. Students were advised to view failures as learning opportunities and not as insurmountable obstacles. Resilience and perseverance were emphasized as key qualities in overcoming challenges.
7. **Seeking Support:** Recognizing the importance of emotional support, the lecture encouraged students to seek guidance from teachers, mentors, and peers. Building a support network can provide valuable insights, motivation, and a sense of camaraderie.

Conclusion: The lecture on facing the fear of competitive exams proved to be a valuable resource for UG students preparing for such challenges. By addressing the psychological aspects of exam anxiety and providing practical strategies for preparation, the session aimed to empower students to approach competitive exams with confidence and resilience. 




