

Sub: District Collectorate, Kakinada District - 20 Day Remedial instruction for inmates of Social Welfare Hostels pursuing pre-metric education from 27 February 2023-March 18 March 2023- Roping in N.S.S volunteers of Degree Colleges of the District for instruction - instructions and SOP issued for implementationregarding.

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PREAMBLE

- It is observed by the District Administration of Kakinada that the pre-metric students residing in Social Welfare Hostels of Kakinada district require remedial coaching to improve the understanding levels of the subject and enhance their outcome attainments in the ensuing examinations.
- Accordingly, the District Administration, in collaboration with the Government ,Aided and Private Un-Aided Degree Colleges of the District, had planned to offer remedial coaching through volunteers of National Service Scheme [N.S.S] for the inmates of Social Welfare Hostels between February 27, 2023 and 18 March 2023 in the respective hostels through offline mode of instruction.
- The programme is intended not only to improve the academic standards of the students of SW hostels but also fine tune the teaching skills of N.S.S volunteers and community service.

ORDER:

Hence, the District Collector and Magistrate, hereby allocates the Hostels of Social Welfare Department in various mandals of the Kakinada District among the Degree Colleges for facilitating remedial coaching. The details of concerned ASWOs and respective Nodal Officers of colleges are tabulated in Annexure I. The detailed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) is given hereunder. The Principals of degree colleges drafted for remedial coaching are instructed to follow the SOP scrupulously and involve the N.S.S volunteers in the programme duly following the schedule furnished.

STANDARED OPERATING PROCEDURE [SOP]

 The Hostel Welfare Officers [Wardens] of Hostels shall contact the respective Nodal Officers of the College and furnish the details for remedial coaching in the proforma prescribed in Annexure –II.

- The College Nodal Officer shall visit the hostel in person, interact with the hostel warden and pre-metric students [Classes VII- X], by 24 February 2023 and prepare the action plan for offering remedial coaching [Annexure-III].
- The nodal officer shall, in collaboration with concerned subject lecturers and volunteers, shall allocate the modules (Uncovered topics & difficult topics for revision/ doubt clarification in all subjects) for remedial teaching among the advanced learners of NSS volunteers by 25 February 2023 in Annexure III and circulate among the NSS volunteers and students of the hostels.
- The Remedial coaching shall start on 27 February 2023 and shall be completed at least one week before the commencement of their annual examinations, preferably by 18 March 2023.
- The Concerned Nodal Officer of the college shall inform the details of the remedial coaching in the Annexure IV to the Chief Programme Director – Sri P.V. Krishna Rao, Head of the Department English, Pithapur Rajah's College [A], Kakinada (9948271991) by 19 March 2023 in the Annexure IV.
- The Managements and Principals of Degree Colleges, Nodal officers of the colleges, ASWOs and Hostel Welfare Officers are requested to bestow personal interest in offering remedial coaching for improving the quality of learning and outcome attainment of students pursuing education through SW hostels.
- The ASWOs are directed to facilitate the smooth running of the programme through Hostel Welfare Officers and Nodal Officers of the College. The ASWOs are requested to collect the feedback and impact of the remedial coaching on the learning levels and subject understanding from the hostel students and submit to the Chief Programme Director and Joint Director, Social Welfare Department by 20 March 2023.
- The Chief Programme Director and Joint Director, Social Welfare Department shall submit the consolidated information to the District Collector by 21 March 2023.
- The Pithapur Govt. College [A], Kakinada is the nodal college for coordinating the said programme. The ASWOs and Hostel welfare officers are requested to coordinate with Chief Programme Director – Sri P.V. Krishna Rao (9948271991) and Asst. Programme Director Mrs.P. Leena (9505964656) for further details.
- The Principal, Pithapur Rajah's Govt. College [A], Kakinada and the Joint Director, Social Welfare Department, Kakinada are requested to instruct ASWOs, Hostel Wardens of Social Welfare Hostels and concerned college nodal officers to implement the programme and comply with orders.
