





RRC members may know the principle and procedure for blood grouping test. Knowing the blood type of donors and recipients is of the utmost important. They found that O positive is the most common blood type followed by AB positive. They recorded only 2 students, WITH o negative blood group blood grouping minimise the reactions during blood transmutation and pregnancy.

Blood donation camp- blood donation camp was conducted in association with Rotary blood bank, kakinada. A total of 41 Volunteers donated their blood. They emphasised that blood donation was the most significant contribution one can save the lives. Highlighted voluntary blood donation. 
