### **Brief Report of the Activity:**

60 students of all B.A along with History, Economics and Political Science departments went to a Study tour to Mothu Gudem power project & Water falls of Maredumilli & ITDA Rampachodavaram. On 05/01/2022

Mothugudem is a village in the East Godavari district of the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. It is located in Chintur mandal. Mothugudem waterfalls is a mesmerizing waterfall situated near Polluru village in Chinturu Mandal of Khammam district in Telangana. Also known as Mothugudem Falls, it is one of the popular places to visit near Maredumilli. Locally known as Thadikevagu Falls, the waterfall is nestled in the Lakkavaram forest range of Bhadrachalam. This enchanting waterfall has several streams flowing in three stages. It is brimming with visitors from far and near particularly on weekends. The water is crystal clear and take a bath in this falls is very refreshing. The falls is in full spate and avoid getting into the water during monsoon.

One can also go for a trek into the surrounding forest. There is no direct public transportation to reach the falls. Tourists have to make their own arrangements to reach this wonderful destination. One needs to reach Chinturu by bus from Bhadrachalam or Maredumilli and then Mothugudem. There is a mud road till the falls from the entrance. The students observed the nature and culture of Tribals, Power plant etc. and they gain knowledge.



## **Field Trip to Archaeology Museum Kakinada**

A.S.P. Archaeology Museum was established in 1919 in a private building. But it was shifted by Prabhala Sundara Ramayya into a Permanent building near Town railway station road, very near to Raja Tank. In this Museum So many sculptures, various ages god idols, inscriptions like copper, pillar inscriptions, stone inscriptions coins made by copper, silver of different ages Tools of stone ages, Indus valley civilization and No. of historical books palm leaf texts and also written chronology of Telugu script etc. Students impressed to know the history of different ages sources seen by them.
