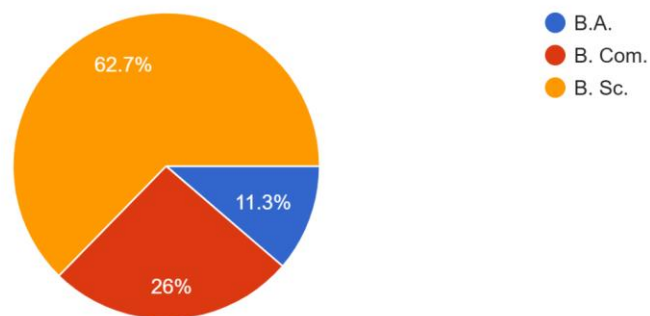

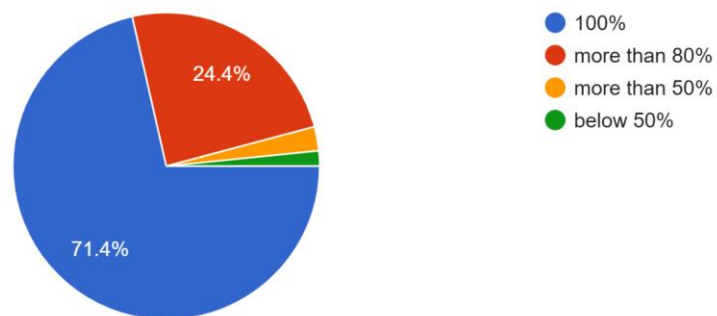

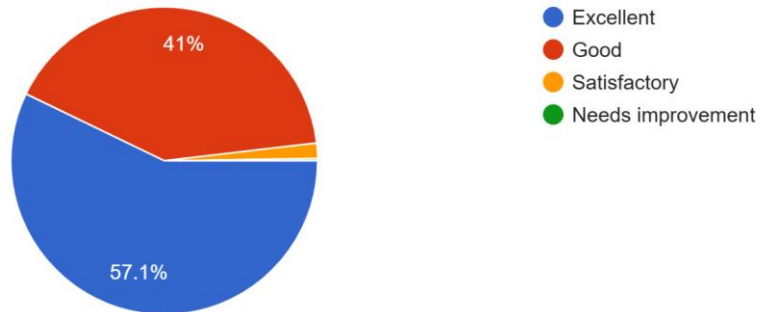
3. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

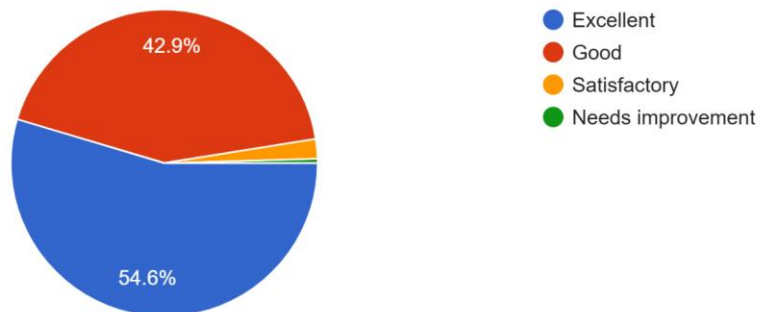
4. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

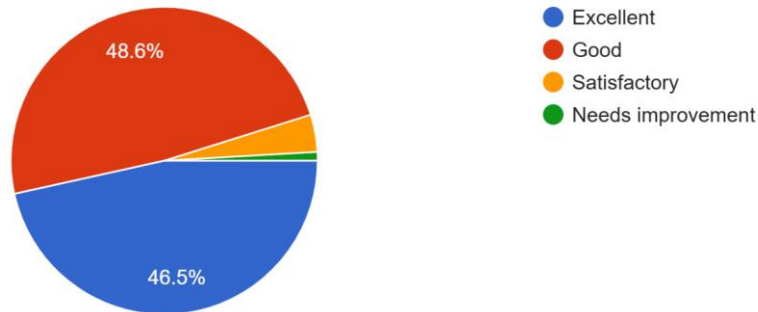
5. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

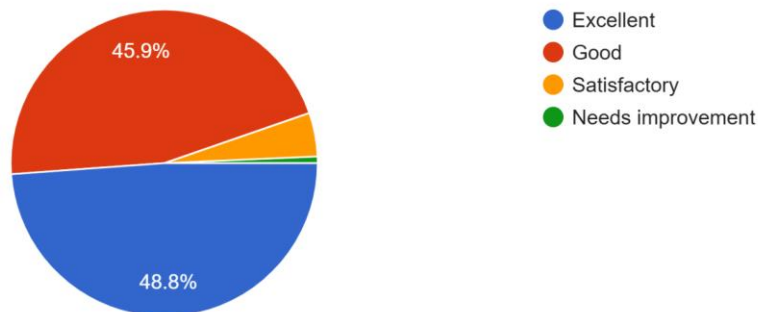
6. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

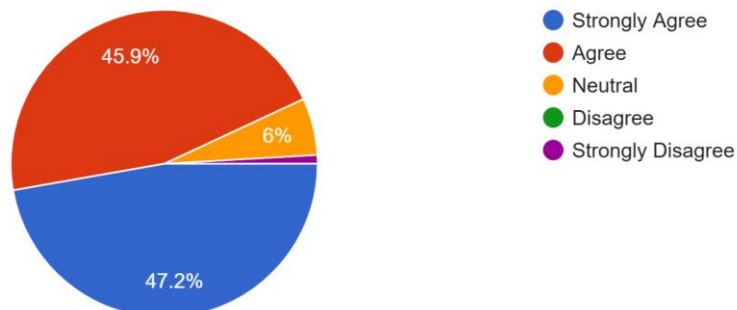
7. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

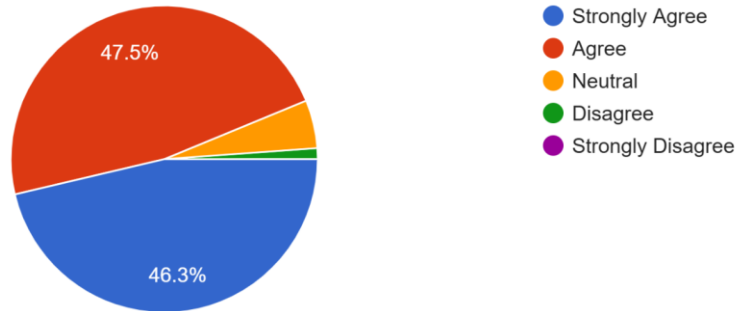
8. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

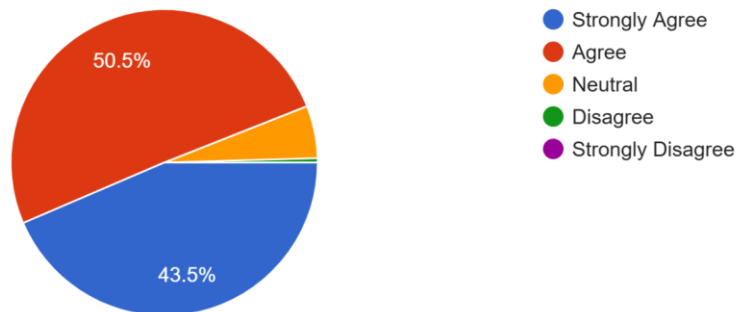
9. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

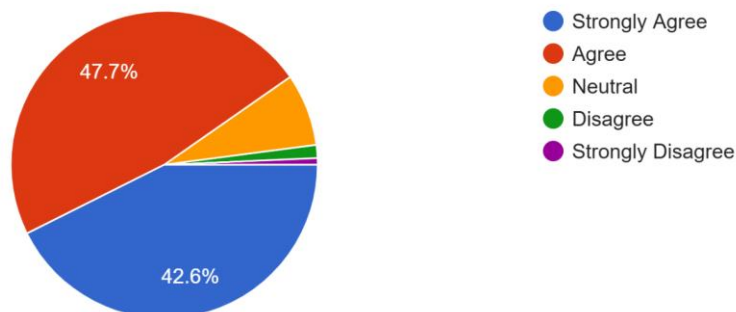
10. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

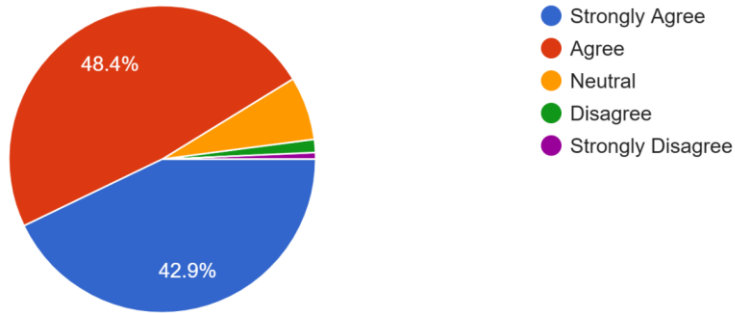
11. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

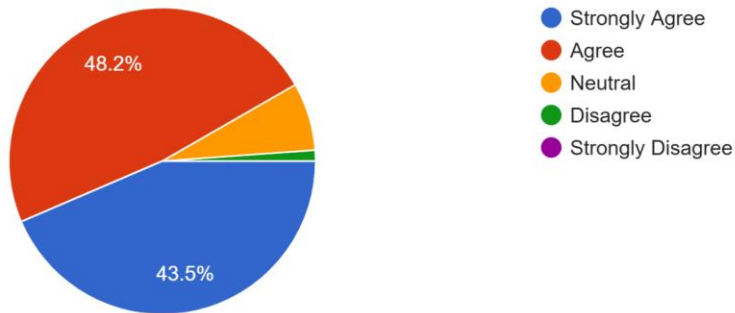
12. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

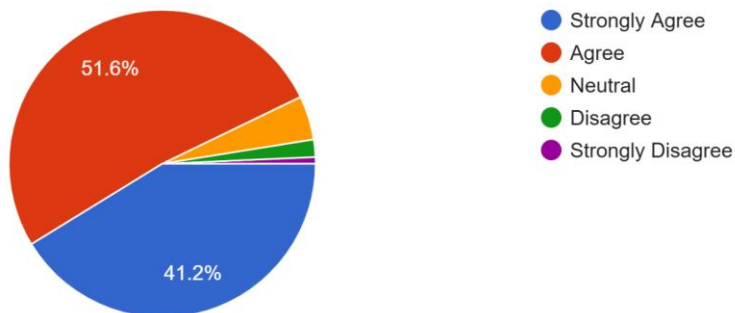
13. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

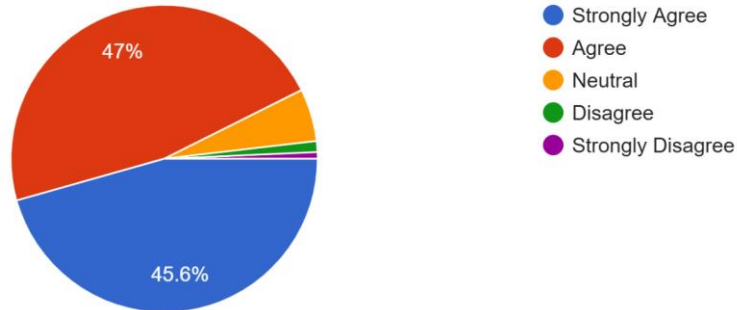
14. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

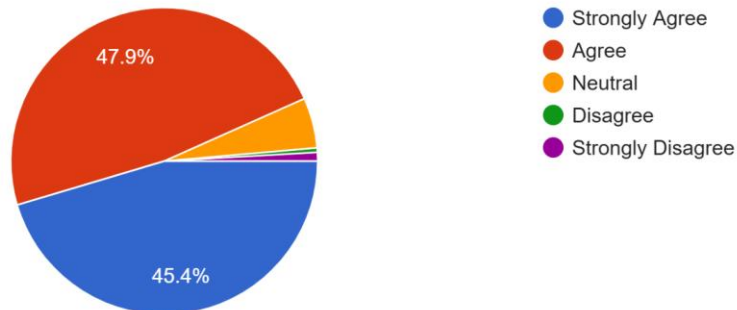
15. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.

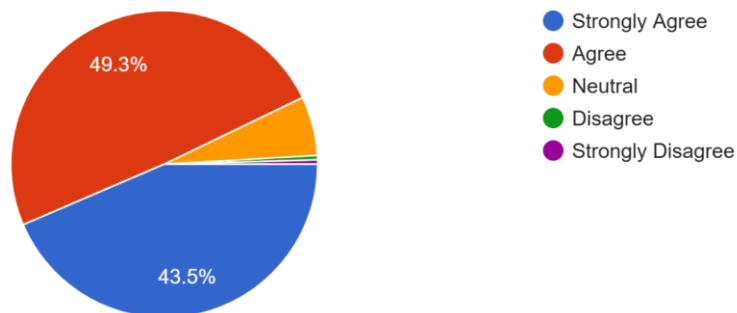
16. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

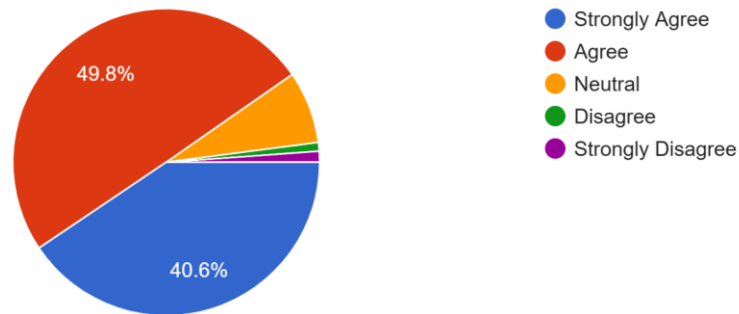
17. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

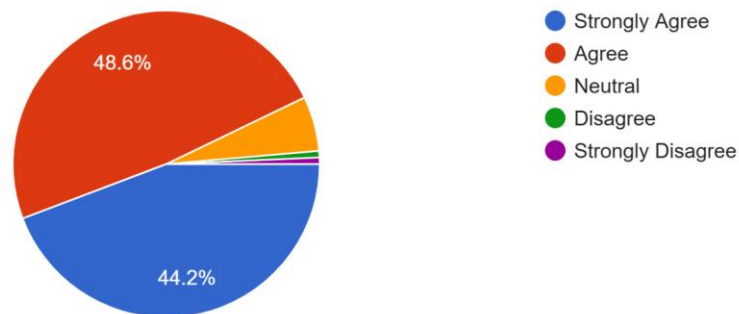
18. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

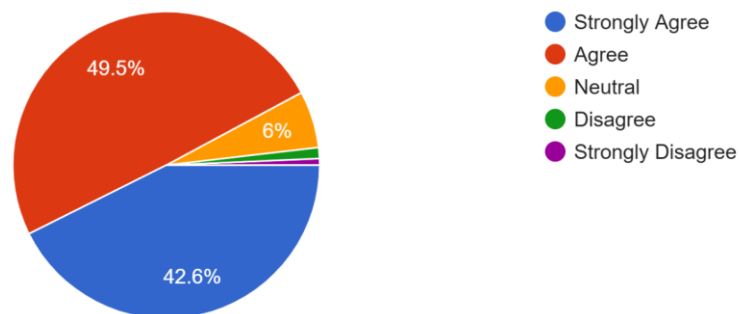
19. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.

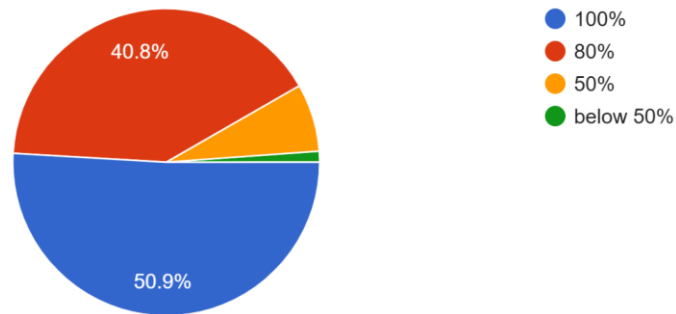
20. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

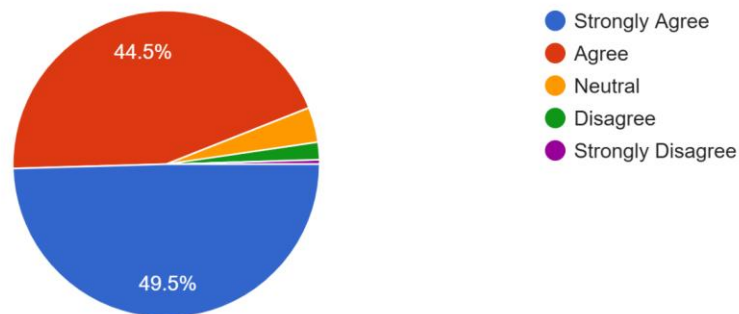
21. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT

OBSERVATIONS:

The following are the observations made Student Satisfaction Survey taken in Online mode from 434 students:

1. The analysis done on the student satisfaction survey indicates that the faculty and institution are doing well in many areas, particularly in teaching quality, communication, and student engagement.
2. Many students highlighted the positive influence of teachers in motivating them and pushing them to participate in various activities and competitions.
3. Most of the students were satisfied with workshops being organized on the recent advancements in their relevant areas of study.
4. Some students expressed the need for more support to students with diverse needs to create a more inclusive environment.
5. While technology usage was appreciated in teaching and learning, it was suggested that its use could be expanded in the assessment process.
6. Students mentioned the need for better lab facilities and improvements in infrastructure.
7. It is also observed that the students mentioned their need to have trainings to improve communication skills , especially in English and guidance related to competitive examinations, so that it could be beneficial for their academic and professional growth.
8. Some students requested for more campus recruitment opportunities.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT:

1. All the faculty were appreciated for their efforts in providing quality education and further requested to continue to foster open communication in the class.
2. All the Departments were encouraged to organize more workshops on the recent advancements in their relevant subjects to provide a exposure to the students.
3. Mentor-Mentee system followed in the institution is further strengthened by organizing periodic parent teacher meetings and keeping parents informed about their ward's performance.
4. Teachers were provided with training to address diverse learning needs, ensuring every student feels included and supported.
5. Faculty were encouraged to explore more digital assessment tools to make the assessment process easier and more efficient for both students and teachers.
6. Trainings on improving Communication skills of the students and guidance to prepare for competitive examinations were organized periodically in collaboration with Career guidance cell of the college and some Non-profit organizations.
7. Efforts will be made to establish stronger ties with industry partners, aiming to increase campus recruitment opportunities and internships for students.
8. Continuous efforts will be made to improve infrastructure, technology integration, and the overall campus environment to better serve students' needs.


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
