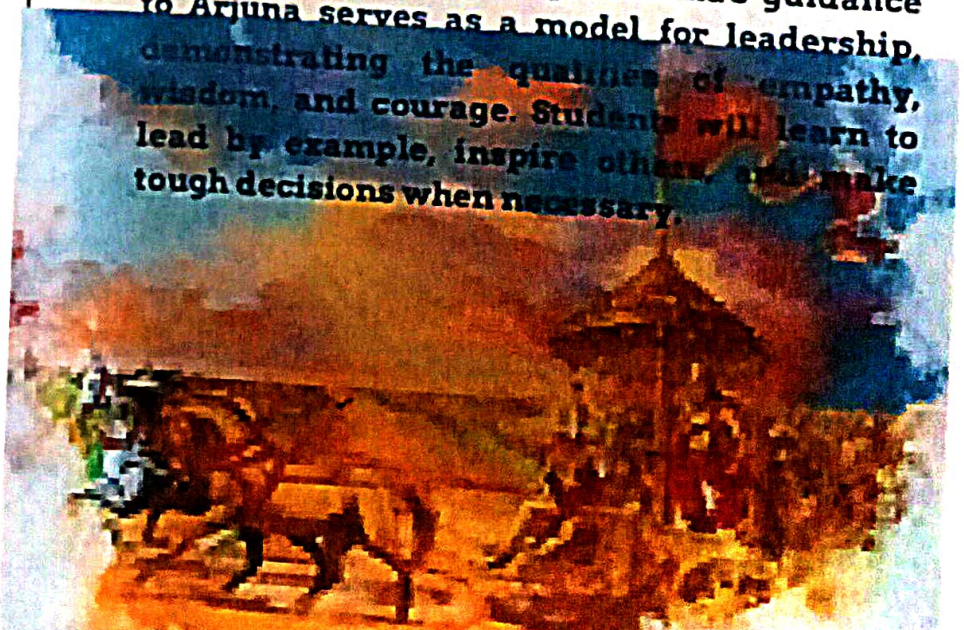

7. Embrace change and uncertainty with equanimity, just as Arjuna faced the challenges of war. (Chapter 2, Verse 14)
8. Make decisions with integrity, fairness, and compassion, considering the greater good, just as Krishna advised Arjuna. (Chapter 1, Verse 36)
9. Encourage continuous learning, self-reflection, and self-improvement, just as Arjuna learned from Krishna. (Chapter 4, Verse 37)
10. Focus on the present moment, without attachment or distraction, just as Krishna taught Arjuna to stay focused. (Chapter 2, Verse 62)
11. The Gita emphasizes the importance of performing one's duties without attachment to the results. This principle can be applied to teamwork by focusing on the collective goal rather than individual gains. - (Chapter 2, Verse 47) "Your right is to perform your duty only, but never to its fruits.
