It was formally inaugurated on 2nd Oct. 1962 by Dr. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy, the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh. The College was managed by the Annaram Devasthanam Trust till 1968 and then was handed over to the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The College has become a full-fledged Government College with effect from 1968. The Motto of the College is "Sthree VidyaPravardathaam".
