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Title of the Practice: SAMANA- A STUDENT FAIR

Aim:

Keeping in mind of the practical life aspects, the implementation of an event to demonstrate and inculcate core essential skills within the student community.

Objectives of the Practice:

An event is to be conducted to tap the talents and potential of the students. The objectives of the practice include:

- To showcase the latent skills and inculcate entrepreneurial abilities among the students.
- To create awareness on the preparation of a budget proposal, banking transactions, and project proposals for start-ups.
- To provide first-hand experiences on consumer behaviors
- To empower the students on how to market their skills
- To help the students earn while they learn

The Context:

The "SAMANA" Student Fair is an initiative by the Department of Commerce, established in 2015. It began with students of Commerce Department operating stalls as sellers, but was later adopted as a best practice for all interested students. The fair initially only allowed college students, but was expanded to include families and the surrounding community, resulting in a larger scale event.



Practice:

Higher education institutes aim to impart knowledge, but in the current competitive landscape, this is not enough. Students require employment and entrepreneurship skills as well. It's essential for graduates to possess more than just academic knowledge to succeed in the present economic climate. Institutes offer courses to develop these skills.

The commerce department invites proposals for stalls at the fair, which is later informed to the students. On the day before the fair, necessary arrangements are made by relevant teachers. Each student is charged a fee for their stall and assigned a stall number. On the day of the fair, students set up their stalls and get ready for the inauguration by a local prominent person and the college principal.

The "SAMANA" student fair provides students a platform to use their skills and creativity commercially. It is a rare opportunity as students may possess skills but not know how to commercially utilize them. With the guidance of teachers, students learn project planning, budgeting and production based on demand. They also gain the ability to calculate profit/loss, estimate costs, and selling prices. These skills are particularly beneficial for female students who may not want to work after marriage and can start their own businesses.

Evidence of Success:

Initially the fair arranged in 2015 saw few stalls and only 50 commerce students participating. Over the years, the number of stalls and participants has grown significantly. By 2020-21, the stalls improved in both quantity and quality. Participants included not only students, but also locals, parents, and junior college students. The students also earned a good profit on their investments.

Problems Encountered and Resources required:

The foremost problem encountered upon initiation of the practice was the low motivation of the students. The teachers had to work hard to motivate them. Another major problem encountered was the time that both the teachers and the students had to spend on planning and preparing for the fair, due to the hectic academic schedule in the semester. As the majority of the students in the institution come from low and marginalized families, investing a small amount in setting up a stall was also a big challenge for the students. The parents of the students were skeptical about getting back the amount invested by their children, and it was therefore very difficult to convince them.

Notes (Optional):

This practice can be adopted by any higher education institutions as it brings out the latent talents and potentials of the students. This approach exposes students to a business-like atmosphere and enhances their abilities to plan and carry out projects, comprehend business profit and loss, and improve marketing skills. Such experience obtained during their time as students can pave the way for those who aspire to establish their own start-ups post completion of their academic education.

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REPORT ON SKILL HUB INITIATIVE

The college submitted a proposal for initiation of "Skill Hub Initiative" in the institution to National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), New Delhi. In response to this, NSDC sanctioned this project "Skill Hub Initiative" to the institution under PMKVY 3.0 scheme and accredited the institution to run this project for the year 2021 - 22.

The Skill Hubs would cover competency-based vocational training for the following target segments:

- a) **In-school students** (6 th class onwards) with Class 6-8 th students receiving orientation and exposure to vocational skill and training (along with visits to local artisans, craftsmen and local manufacturing/processing units on bagless days) while Class 9-12th being offered a skill as course work having access to dedicated skill labs.
- b) **School Dropouts** (in the 6 th to 12 th Class cohort) between the age group of 15-29years.
- c) **Out-of-education candidates** (between age group of 15-29 years) to achieve Skill Certificate and academic credit through Skilling/ Re-skilling/ Up-skilling courses along with employment linkages

Under this project, a short – term training course namely "Self – Employed Tailor" was sanctioned for the year 2021 – 22. The NOS category of this course is "Apparel Made-Ups & Home Furnishing Sector Skill Council".

The institution invited applications from the target segments mentioned above, through social media and print media. 32 candidates were enrolled and a batch was created to train the candidates. A separate lab was established with 15 sewing machines (5 sewing machines were donated by an alumna and 10 by a local NGO).

The training course was commenced on 7th March, 2022 and ended on 29th June, 2022 with 360 hours of duration (90 hours for Theory and 270 hours for practical's).

The attendance was marked for the candidates through AEBAS (Aadhar Enabled Biometric Attendance System) operated by NSDC, New Delhi.

After completion of this training programme, an assessment was conducted for 23 candidates in the institution on 4th July, 2022 by the assessment agency "IQAG".

Out of 23 candidates, who appeared for the assessment, 22 candidates got through the assessment and received certificates from the institution.

A grant of Rs. 1,32,800 was sanctioned to the institution for this project for the year 2021 – 22.

Greetings from UGC! This is regarding **SKILL HUB INITIATIVE**. I am glad to share with you that towards the overall goal of integrating vocational education with general education and under the guidance of Hon'ble Minister of Education and Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship have envisioned for skill training hubs across the country. Further, it is envisaged that in the first phase, 5,000 such Skill Hubs shall be identified.

Skill Hubs may be identified from among the following entities:

- a. Schools (Government, Government Aided and Private)
- b. Higher Education Institutions (Engineering, Technical and General Institutions)
- c. Polytechnics
- d. Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs)
- e. Other Govt Skilling Institutions
- f. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs)
- g. Private Training Providers (PMKVY centres, Fee based centres)
- h. Training Centres of Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS)
- i. Corporate Skill Institutions

The Skill Hubs would cover competency-based vocational training for the following target segments:

- a. **In-school students** (6th class onwards) with Class 6-8th students receiving orientation and exposure to vocational skill and training (along with visits to local artisans, craftsmen and local manufacturing/processing units on bagless days) while Class 9-12th being offered a skill as course work having access to dedicated skill labs.
- b. **School Dropouts** (in the 6th to 12th Class cohort) between the age group of 15-29years
- c. **Out-of-education** candidates(between age group of 15-29 years) to achieve Skill Certificate and academic credit through Skilling/ Re-skilling/ Up-skilling courses along with employment linkages

The Skill Hub Initiative shall be implemented through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) under the Central Component of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana 3.0 (PMKVY 3.0). Funds shall be provided to the participant institutions on per student basis. Funds shall be routed through NSDC to Skill Hubs and Certified Trainees directly.

Attendance: The Biometric Attendance shall be made mandatory for Trainee, Trainers and Assessors.

Assessment and Certification: The assessment and certification process shall be as per guidelines and norms issued by MSDE/NCVET from time to time. Institutions including Schools and HEIs or any other Awarding Body (approved by NCVET) which are already offering skilling-based courses through their

respective School Education/Technical Boards may have the flexibility to undertake assessment and certification as per their existing norms if they offer NSQF aligned/approved courses.

Skill Hub Initiative shall commence from 1st January, 2022.

NSDC is going to organize an online orientation programme on 23rd December, 2021 at 11.30 A.M. for the institutions which wish to become Skill Hubs and participate in the Initiative.

UGC has initially identified a few institutions for participation in the Initiative. The institutions identified as Skill Hubs may offer short-term skill-based programmes / courses in one or two trades / job roles enrolling school dropout students (class 12 or so). **You are requested to kindly confirm your participation in the Initiative by a return e-mail latest by 20th December, 2021. You are also requested to share the job roles / trades which you are going to offer. Information to be provided by the college should be in the following order:**

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 has recommended incorporation of vocational skills into School and Higher Education curriculums so that students can design their own paths of study and life plans. To mainstream vocational education, sharing of infrastructure and developing well-defined pathways for students to continue with their chosen academic-vocational pursuits, an initiative for creation of Skill Hubs across the education and skill ecosystem has been proposed to actualize the intent on the ground.

Roles of Training Partners (TPs):

1. TPs need to ensure that their Training Centers are Accredited and Affiliated
2. TPs need to ensure that they have ToT certified Trainer
3. TPs need to ensure that they have AEBAS installed for marking candidate, trainer and TC SPOC attendance
4. TPs need to ensure that candidates are mobilized and enrolled as per the job role criteria
5. TPs need to ensure branding is as per mandate

Draft Concept Note Skill Hub Initiative under PMKVY Scheme

1. Background

Low employability of pass-outs at various levels is often attributed to the lack of application and practical learning to prepare an individual for the world of work. It is also indicated by several macroeconomic studies that the employability of individuals and productivity of the economy is impacted by high drop-out ratios post-secondary education with candidates joining informal workforce as semi-skilled labour. Integration and mainstreaming of vocational education with general education has been identified as the key reform in the education-skill system of the country for overall gains at the student, community and economy levels.

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 envisages quality holistic education-including vocational education so that students can design their own paths of study and life plans. In this context, the policy has recommended incorporation of vocational skills into School and Higher Education curriculums so as to attain 50% vocational exposure for children by 2025.

NEP 2020 while emphasizing flexibility in choice of subjects strongly recommends no hard separations between the vocational and academic streams, etc. in order to eliminate harmful hierarchies and silos between different areas of learning. To mainstream vocational education and to enable removal of academic silos, a Credit-based Framework to ensure vertical and horizontal pathways for students has also been envisaged. On the infrastructure front, NEP 2020 envisions shared infrastructure of Skilling and General Education.

To mainstream vocational education, sharing of infrastructure and developing well-defined pathways for students to continue with their chosen academic-vocational pursuits, an initiative for creation of Skill Hubs across the education and skill ecosystem has been proposed to actualize the intent on the ground.

The proposed Skill Hub Initiative shall be housed under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 3.0 scheme being implemented by Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE).

2. Aims and Objectives

It is expected that existing resources in education and skilling system can be put to optimum usage by utilization for skilling beyond normal working hours and during weekends. The Skill Hubs Initiative (SHI) under PMKVY accordingly aims at creating shared infrastructure, aligning with the needs of the local economy and addressing the needs of all target segments for vocational training. The SHI is aimed at the following:

- a. Provision of permanent vocational infrastructure and resources for skilling
- b. To ensure contiguous availability of skill centers for ease of candidates
- c. Align the vocational offerings at all levels with overall economic and local economy needs
- d. Introduce vocational learning at an early stage with multiple well-defined pathways for candidates to continue with their chosen vocations

- e. Provide vocational offerings for target segments including in-school, drop-outs and out-of-education candidates

3. Key Enablers for Skill Hubs Initiative

- a. A simplified Credit Framework for assignment, transfer and accumulation of credits for both academic and vocational credits
- b. Consensus on acceptance of vocational credits for entry into higher education and Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)
- c. Interim guidelines for inclusion of vocational subject in Schools until institutionalized by the National Curriculum Framework (NCF)
- d. Suitable academic equivalence through National/State institutes of Open School (NIOS/SIOS) for drop-outs/out-of-education candidates wherever feasible in addition to credit assignment

4. Target Beneficiaries

For the overall integration of skilling with education, vocational education shall be introduced from Class 6 onwards through introduction to the 'World of Work' through orientation, industry visits and bag-less days. The industry visits may also cover visits to local artisans, craftsmen, local manufacturing units, etc. The foundation concepts of courses mapped for Class 9 onwards may be used for Class 6-8 for better synergy. Such vocational needs shall be addressed at Schools as per NCERT guidelines.

The Skill Hubs would offer NSQF compliant vocational courses for the following target segments:

- a. **In-school students** (Class 9-12th student cohort): Shall be offered a vocational offering as course work having access to dedicated skill labs in identified skill hubs.
- b. **School Dropouts** (6th to 12th Class cohort): To achieve vocational skill certification and academic credit through credit assignment and mainstreaming back to school wherever feasible. Candidates shall also be supported with career counselling before and after training. For children who have dropped out of class 6/7/8, option for continuing vocational education along with mainstreaming will be done.
- c. **Out-of-education candidates:** To achieve vocational skill certificate and academic credit through Skilling/ Re-skilling/ Up-skilling courses along with employment linkages - Wage/ Self Employment / Apprenticeship.

5. Identification and characteristics of Skill Hubs

In the pilot phase of the Skill Hubs initiative, 5,000 Skill Hubs shall be assigned through the participation of Schools, Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs), Polytechnics, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSSs), NIELIT Centres, RSETIs, Engineering Colleges, and General Higher Education Institutions under the administrative aegis of several Ministries including MoE, MSDE, MeitY and MoRD. The Hubs have been identified taking into consideration geo-spatial contiguity and to ensure that there is relative homogeneity in availability of such Hubs across all districts in the country. The break-up of Skill Hubs across administrative Ministries is the following:

The details on key characteristics and selection parameters of Skill Hubs are given at **Annexure-I**.

6. Operationalization of Skill Hubs

The operationalization of skill hubs shall be based on differentiation between courses, resource intensity, type of institution identified as Skill Hub, pedagogy and objectives of vocational offerings for in-school and out-of-education candidates.

District Skill Committees (DSCs) would play a pivotal role in implementation of the SHI and shall be responsible for mapping of local skill demand. They will also support skill hubs through support for mobilization, counselling and placement. DSCs would also be involved in monitoring and supervision of the SHI at the district level and coordinating with nodal implementing agency at the center.

Integration for In-school students

- **Schools:** Skill hubs emanating from Schools shall introduce vocational trades prescribed in the *Samagra Siksha* vocational scheme with suitable enhancement in scope as per the Skill Hubs Guidelines in the pilot phase. Over time, they shall incorporate the courses identified through demand mapping from the local economy.
- **Higher Education Institutions:** Skill hubs emanating from Higher Education Institutions including Engineering Colleges, Polytechnics and General Education Institutions shall introduce vocational trades prescribed in the *Samagra Siksha* vocational scheme (the list of vocational courses/ job roles under Samagra Siksha is given at **Annexure-II**) or similar other NSQF aligned short duration courses relevant for in-school students with suitable enhancement in scope as per the Skill Hubs Guidelines in the pilot phase. Over time, they shall incorporate the courses identified through demand mapping from the local economy.
- **Skill Hubs from MSDE System:** Skill Hubs emanating from ITI, PMKKs, JSS, etc. shall follow the Hub-n-Spoke model for operationalization the scheme wherein aspects of vocational education (theory part) are catered to in school classrooms and practical training at such skill hubs for 1-2 days a week through commute facilitation. Skill Hubs from MSDE System shall introduce vocational courses prescribed in the *Samagra Shiksha* vocational scheme in the pilot phase.
- **Skill Hubs from other Skill Institutions:** In the pilot phase, Skill hubs emanating from non-MoE and MSDE system shall introduce vocational courses prescribed in

the *Samagra Shiksha* vocational scheme for catering to in-school students. Over time (say over 2 years), they are expected to increase the scope of their offerings to match the demand mapping from district level and secondary sources. Delivery mechanism shall be similar to hub-n-spoke model.

Integration for Out-of-education candidates

- **Schools:** Short Term training courses will be offered in the premises of schools designated as skill hubs for out-of-education youth after school hours or weekends as the case may be. The courses shall be based on the vocational courses being offered in the *Samagra Shiksha* in the pilot phase. Over time, courses identified through demand mapping from the local economy shall be incorporated. Schools may avail the services of private vocational training providers for offering vocational courses to out-of-education candidates. However, the schools will be responsible for meeting the requirements and reporting of skill hubs to scheme administrative authorities. It is expected that Schools will be able to develop internal vocational capacities over time. The operational issues related to administration (security, timings, etc.) of skill hubs at Schools shall be handled by State Govt. /KVS/ NVS/ CBSE as the case may be.
- **Higher Education Institutions (HEIs):** Short Term training courses will be offered in the premises of the HEIs designated as skill hubs for out-of-education candidates. In the pilot phase, the courses may be based on the vocational courses being offered in the *Samagra Shiksha* or similar NSQF aligned courses which they are already offering. Over time, they shall incorporate the courses identified through demand mapping from the local economy.
- **MSDE Skill Institutions:** Vocational offerings shall be in the form of fresh skilling, re-skilling and up-skilling vocational courses. The offerings shall be derived from a judicious mix of universal trades and those pertaining to local economy needs.
- **Skill Hubs from other Skill Institutions:** Skill Hubs from skill institutions of other Ministries shall expand the scope of their offerings to cater to out-of-education candidates. The vocational offerings would be similar to other Skill Hubs from education or skill systems in the pilot phase.

7. Key characteristics and functions of Skill Hubs

Identified skill subs shall be the delivery points for vocational offerings with a number of functions and responsibilities:

- a. **Permanent Vocational Infrastructure:** Skill Hubs shall leverage their existing vocational infrastructure and further improve the same over time to have vocational resources catering to a judicious mix of traditional and new age vocational offerings.
- b. **Mobilization:** The Skill Hub would work in close coordination with adjoining schools and skilling institutions (spokes) for extending mobilization support, referring candidates based on the job role(s) and facilitating the initial registration process on the Skill India Portal.

- c. **Counselling Services:** Skill Hubs would provide pre and post-training counselling services to trainees based on aptitude and psychometric tests. Counselling services provisioned at Skill Hubs for out-of-education candidates may also be leveraged by Schools at times of entry to Class 9 and Class 11 for better screening of candidates in various streams. A brief note on the mechanism and offerings under Career Counselling is appended in appendix 1.
- d. **Trainer Engagement:** Skill Hubs would engage vocational trainers and strengthen the vocational capacity required for catering to the required volume of candidates in line with demand. Online training and orientation may be conducted by MSDE/MoE/implementing agency to identify trainers if supply is found to be a challenge in certain areas/districts.
- e. **Training:** Skill Hubs would provide training on courses which are aligned to NSQF. Suitable credit assignment and accumulation for Internship program have to be ensured.
- f. **Placement Support:** Skill Hubs would facilitate and managing placements including industry linkages, apprenticeship opportunities, entrepreneurship support and post-placement follow-up. In addition to wage employment, self-employment, apprenticeships and mainstreaming to education (academic or vocational) could be considered equivalent to placement. For immediate school drop outs, mainstreaming back to general or vocational education through credit / certification from NIOS shall be especially targeted. In addition, they may also be encouraged to be designated as NIOS/SIOS registration and exam centers.
- g. Skill hubs shall address aspects of safety and security of candidates including in-school students who may have to commute to non-school skill hubs for vocational training.
- h. **Other Services:** Skill Hubs may support spokes for delivery of life skills, digital training and provide access to the SMART classroom facility of the hub for virtual training.

8. Implementation Mechanism

- a. **Vocational Course selection and mapping:** Vocational demand aggregation and mapping shall be undertaken through District Skill Committees (DSCs) and validated through secondary sources. In the pilot phase, SSA Vocational Courses shall be offered which shall be upgraded to 'universal' trades and local economy relevant trades in the next phases. Skill Institutions from non-education system may offer employment linked courses with placement support as detailed in 7 (f).
- b. **Implementation Agency:** SSDM/ Any centrally identified agency shall be the Implementing Agency and funds shall be routed from MSDE to SSDMs / State level Educational Institutions/ Any Centrally identified agency. Based on requirements, these implementing agencies shall release funds to respective Hubs.

- c. **Career Counselling:** Once the candidate is registered, he/she will undergo career counselling/ guidance. The career counselling shall be facilitated by DSCs at the district level.
- d. **District level facilitation:** Verification of availability of premises and trainers would be carried out through the DSCs.
- e. **Support Services** in implementation including Training of Trainers (ToT), National Test for Trainers, portal-based IT support, Career Counselling solution, advisory on the strengthening of Skill Hubs, Empanelment of Skill Hubs, Monitoring, etc. will be provided through the implementing agency with technical support from NSDC where required.
- f. **Target allocation:** Target shall be assigned to the Skill Hubs based on selection criteria/ metrics linked to infrastructure, training capacity, past skilling experience if any, geographical operation, etc. and data of trainee life cycle shall be put on the Skill India Portal through a simple automated process.
- g. **Biometric Attendance** shall be made mandatory for Trainee (excluding In School candidates), Trainers and Assessors.
- h. **The assessment and certification** process shall be as per guidelines and norms issued by MSDE/NCVET from time to time. Institutions including Schools and HEIs which are already offering skilling based courses through their respective School Education/Technical Boards may have the flexibility to undertake assessment and certification as per their existing norms if they offer NSQF aligned/approved courses.
- i. **Technology platform:** The Skill India Portal may be suitably strengthened for data upload of identified Skill Hubs, host Accreditation and Affiliation activity, ensuring access to project management units, and other SHI related aspects. Under the SHI, registrations, enrolment and *Aadhar*-based selection of the candidate shall be encouraged and data to be fed on the Skill India Portal (SIP).
- j. **Alignment with PFMS:** All the payments to Skill Hubs and Trainees shall be through DBT (Direct Bank Transfer) and efforts shall be made to align the payment process through PFMS (Public Finance Management System).
- k. **Post Training Support** may be provided for linkages with employment/self-employment/Apprenticeships through various initiatives for the out-of-school segment.

9. Governance mechanism

Skill Hubs program shall be governed as per the following structure:

- a. **Steering Committee** constituted under PMKVY 3.0, as apex level committee for broad policy direction, framing operations guidelines, periodic review, monitoring, mid-course correction and convergence of skills and education will continue for Skill Hub Initiative.

- b. **State Monitoring Committee** shall be constituted at the State level for overseeing the regular functioning of the SHI with participation of State Skill, Education Department and DSCs representatives. For any policy or operational corrections, the state monitoring committee shall seek guidance/approval from Steering Committee for improvising the implementation of the Skill Hub Initiative. The composition and role of the committee shall be detailed in the Operational Guidelines of Skill Hub Initiative.

10. Monitoring Framework and Quality Evaluation

- Skill Hub Initiative will be monitored at various levels to ensure quality outcome. This will include progress monitoring tools such as quarterly progress reports, geo-tagging, and audit, etc. Monitoring would be done via technology-driven interventions. In specific cases where discrepancies are found, physical inspections may also be conducted.
- The monitoring structure, the roles, and responsibilities of key stakeholders in monitoring the program will be the similar as mentioned in PMKVY 3.0 Monitoring guidelines. The ground monitoring agency like District Skill Committee (DSC) and monitoring team from State Skill Development Missions (SSDMs) will be overall responsible for the same.
- Evaluation will have specific emphasis on ensuring quality in training delivery and making skilling aspirational in the country. The implementing agency/coordinating agency will be required to submit progress report and evaluation report time to time.

11. Financial Management

The Steering Committee will be empowered to take appropriate decision regarding target allocation and utilization of funds without affecting the financial provision.

- MSDE may make a provision for financial assistance to select candidates opting for entrepreneurship/self-employment on a screening and competitive basis under its existing programs.
- Reward Money may be deposited directly to the beneficiary candidate using AEPS model.
- The costing is applicable for an average batch size of 30 candidates. Batch size may be increased to a maximum of 40 candidates.

Annexure I: Key characteristics and selection parameters of Skill Hubs

1. Background

Towards the overall goal of integrating vocational education with general education and under the guidance of Hon'ble Minister and MoS, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship have envisioned the setting up of skill training hubs of the country from across education and skill ecosystems such that there are 40-50 institutions each in every district. Further, it is envisaged that in the first phase, 5000 such Skill Hubs may be identified from among the following entities:

1. Schools (Government, Government Aided and Private)
2. Higher Education Institutions (Engineering, Technical and General Institutions)
3. Polytechnics
4. Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs)
5. Other Govt Skilling Institutions
6. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs)
7. Private Training Providers (PMKVY centres, Fee based centres)
8. Corporate Skill Institutions

2. Target Segments

The Skill Hubs would cover competency-based vocational training for the following target segments:

- **In-school students** (6th class onwards) with Class 6-8th students receiving orientation and exposure to vocational skill and training (along with visits to local artisans, craftsmen and local manufacturing/processing units on bagless days) while Class 9-12th being offered a skill as course work having access to dedicated skill labs.
- **School Dropouts** (in the 6th to 12th Class cohort)
- **Out-of-education candidates** to achieve Skill Certificate and academic credit through Skilling/ Re-skilling/ Up-skilling courses along with employment linkages

3. What are Skill Hubs?

Skill Hubs are nodal skill centres identified to provide skill development and vocational training opportunities to target population segments. The identified Skill Hubs should preferably have previous experience in implementing skill development and vocational skilling programs. Each Skill hub will associate with adjoining education and skilling institutions (spokes) over a district, or a cluster of adjacent districts, to provide access to skill development training at hub location or at spoke location. Such adjoining institutions in the vicinity of the Skill Hub may leverage the infrastructure and resources available at the associated Hub for their In-school, drop-outs and out-of-education candidates in the 15-29 age cohort.

Skill Hubs would offer courses / job roles from multiple sectors with infrastructure capacity and strength of suitable Trainers for delivering high-quality skill development training. Trainings at Skill Hubs would be delivered as per the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) and the common cost norms (except Schools).

Since Skill Hubs may be co-opted from both eco-systems -the skilling system (PMKKs, ITIs) and education system (Schools, Polytechnics, Engineering Colleges, other Higher Education Institutions), there may be some variation in their scope and scale of vocational offerings. Skill Hubs identified from the education system may be able to access the services of PMKKs or standalone training providers in schools to assist in provision of vocational training until they develop their own resources over time.

Key characteristics of Skill Hubs

- a. **Permanent Vocational Infrastructure:** Skill Hubs are expected to leverage their existing vocational infrastructure and further improve the same over time to have cutting edge vocational resources catering to a judicious mix of traditional and new age vocational offerings.
- b. **Mobilization:** The Skill Hub would work in close coordination with adjoining schools and training institutions for extending mobilization support, referring candidates based on the job role(s) and facilitating initial registration process on the Skill India Portal.
- c. **Counselling Services:** Skill Hubs would provide pre and post training counselling services to trainees based on aptitude and psychometric tests. It is envisaged that counselling services would be institutionalized at times of entry to Class 9 and Class 11 for better screening of candidates in various streams and Skill Training Hubs services may be leveraged for the same.
- d. **Trainer Engagement:** Skill Hubs would engage vocational trainers and strengthen vocational capacity required for catering to the required volume of candidates in line with demand.
- e. **Placement Support:** Skill Hubs may take a lead in facilitating and managing placements including industry linkages, apprenticeship opportunities, entrepreneurship support and post placement follow-up.
- f. **Other Services:** Skill Hubs may support spokes for delivery of life skills, digital training and also provide access to SMART classroom facility of the hub for virtual trainings.

Accreditation and Affiliation of Skill Hubs

Skill Hubs must be aligned with the infrastructure and equipment requirements as per a standardized Accreditation and Affiliation process (A&A). The Accreditation and Affiliation of Skill Hubs may be supported with a technology platform hosted on the Skill India Portal. The applicable norms for the A&A and Skill Hub on-boarding for Schools and Government Institutions would be suitably amended. On-boarding of Skill Hubs on a centralized platform would allow for building a repository of available training capacity, mapped across geographies and sectors.

On-boarding on Digital Platform

The Skill India Portal may be suitably strengthened for on-boarding of identified Skill Hubs, host Accreditation and Affiliation activity, ensuring access to project management units, Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) and other SHI related aspects. The training life cycle of candidates (batch creation, candidate enrolment, training, assessment and certification) may also be recorded and tracked on the portal. In course of time, the tracking of candidate may be aligned as per the student ID envisaged in the National Digital Education Architecture.

4. Selection Criteria for Skill Hubs Schools

The schools having good infrastructure facilities like separate vocational labs, lab equipment and ICT labs will be designated as hub schools for vocational education under

Samagra Shiksha. They will facilitate vocational education to the in-school students and drop-outs wherever possible. Such hubs will be preferably selected from the schools having experience in vocational education and industry linkages.

Institutions other than Schools

Skill Hubs may be identified in districts falling in three categories (**Category – A, B and C**), depending on the youth population of the district (between 15-29 years). The categorization of districts follows the table below:

Institutions from Higher Education and Other Ministries' Ecosystem: Government Institutions would be referred by respective Ministries (including MoE, MoRD, MeitY, MSME among others) as per the criteria listed below:

a) **Classroom & Vocational / Skill Lab Infrastructure**

Note: The lab area and machinery set-up should be as per the prescribed standards

- b) A computer lab with a minimum of 20 computers
- c) A 3-phase power connection with mandatory power backup
- d) Availability of safe drinking water and sanitary set up
- e) Accessible infrastructure for differently abled students
- f) A demarcated entry / exit for the vocational skill students is preferred
- g) Adherence to fire safety norms prescribed by the Government
- h) Internet connection with a minimum bandwidth of 2MBPS
- i) Availability of at least 1 smart classroom with technology enabled audio-visual and web-enabled access

PMKKs and Standalone Training Providers may continue to be selected based on existing norms under Skill Management and Accreditation of Training Centres (SMART) process.

Infrastructure: The Skill Hub should have available land and building area to expand its expertise to other sectors and trades in the future based on emerging training needs.

Scope and Coverage: The Skill Hub should be able to provide for sector and Vocational / job role coverage, with a minimum requirement as follows:

Clustered/ non-clustered district presence: A cluster comprises of 5-6 contiguous districts within a state. Skill Hubs, depending on their resources, communication facilities, may specify which districts and clusters they will be operating in.

Management and Training Personnel: The Skill Hubs must have experienced vocational training staff, trained and certified as determined under various vocational programs/schemes.

The Skill Hub should preferably have prior experience in conducting skill training programs.

The Skill Hub should demonstrate strong industry tie-ups for field visits, speakers from industry, and placement support for candidates opting for employment post training.

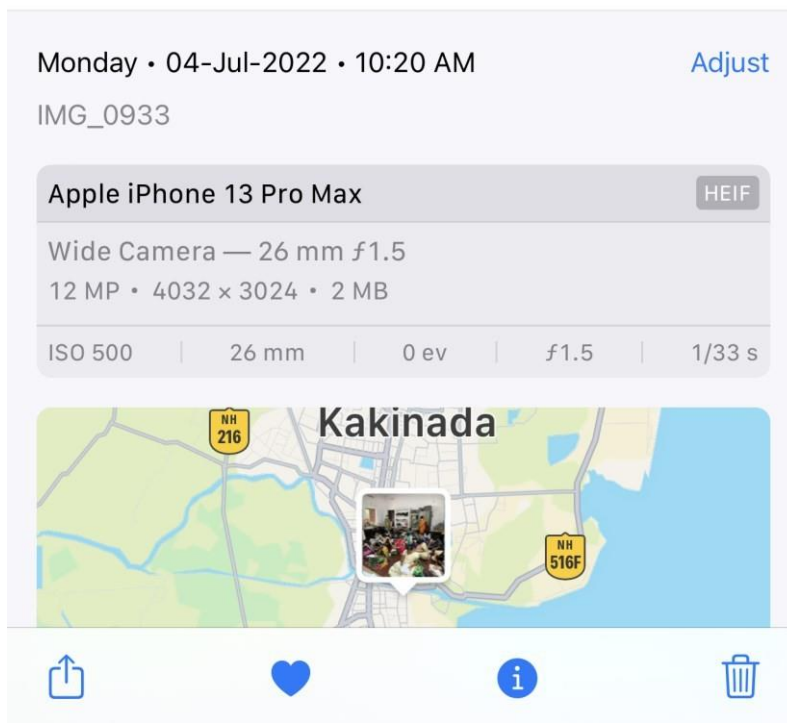

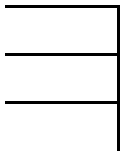
